The results of the pilot course in Stuttgart were realized by Dr Hilary Fabian, UK. She compiled a curriculum for National Courses and Grundtvig Training Courses.

Parents have to participate adequately in these courses as well.

By realizing these courses, it is important that participants exchange their experiences.

After realizing the National Courses, each trainer has to prepare a short report as an evaluation, which will be forwarded to the coordinating institution:
